# Our technologies focus is part of who we are at Coastal Lakes College.

It encompasses the hard and soft skills students require in order to succeed at school and beyond. These skills are embedded in every area of the curriculum across our college.

Our approach means that we can cater to a wide variety of interests, and students have a choice in how they participate.

STEM is taught across our school, in all our subjects. We also have particular focus areas, after-school clubs and specialist programs that allow students to delve deeper into various areas of interest.

This helps to ensure that all students can get involved and find something that they enjoy, whilst developing these fundamental skills.

Two key areas of focus are drones and submersibles.

Our technologies focus encompasses the skills learnt in science, maths, technology and engineering.

It brings alive the soft skills of STEM; problem solving, creativity, critical analysis, teamwork, independent thinking, initiative, communication and digital literacy.

# Our arts facilities are amazing at Coastal Lakes College.

Our inspiring facilities include a dedicated performing arts building with theatre spaces, drama room with a sprung floor, back stage facilities and dressing rooms, a dance studio and multiple green rooms.

We also have a dedicated visual arts building with separate printmaking, drawing, ceramics, film/audio and digital media spaces.

Students will have access to a wide range of resources, technology and facilities that will enable them to develop industry based skills that are essential for 21st Century living and ensure that they have the foundations to a successful future.





Students will have the opportunity to be involved in Dance, Drama and Music Showcases.

They will also have the opportunity to get involved backstage and learn fundamental skills such as sound, lighting, costumes, scenography (stage design/props), directing, stage managing etc.

Students will have the opportunity to work with scripts and develop their own works.

We will showcase student work in our gallery space within our performing arts foyer and in gallery spaces in our wider community.

These opportunities help our students develop good relationships with local community and industry professionals.

In addition to visual and performing arts, students also have access to an incredible music program and after-school club who perform at college events.

Our focus on arts and technology will overlap.

Technology will be used to create art and creativity will be a big part of our technology focus.

## At Coastal Lakes College, we work to remove barriers to inclusion and support all students to achieve their potential.

Coastal Lakes College is an inclusive school. As part of our commitment to inclusivity, we have an Inclusive Education Support Hub that allows students to attend a specialist facility in their local community.

Our integrated location allows us to tailor the education experience for each child, so they can learn in the most appropriate and least restrictive environment.

We believe that every child should be welcome and have their needs met in every classroom.

We can support students with a range of disabilities and learning difficulties, such as complex health, communication and behavioural needs.

For some students with a disability, inclusion means spending a significant part of their day in a highly supported classroom environment. For others, immersion in a mainstream program with support and differentiation is the best learning pathway for them.

Every student in the Hub has an individualised program, they work in small groups to achieve their individual targets.

We have an integrated learning approach that sees all areas of the curriculum taught continually throughout the day. This provides students with practical application for their learning. It also offers multiple opportunities for them to achieve their targets.





## We are well equipped with spacious new facilities at Coastal Lakes College.

Our classrooms are bright and friendly.

We have sensory spaces for students to access throughout the day, keeping them ready to learn.

We have specialist facilities that allow us to cater for the physical, emotional, mental and sensory needs of our students. Highlights of our Inclusive Education Hub include:

- Hydrotherapy pool
- Outdoor sensory play space
- Life skills room
- Physiotherapy room
- Therapy consultant rooms

We also have access to specialist facilities across the school including: art, food, science, the gymnasium, design and technology and computer labs.
